## **ABOUT RECOVERY HOUSING**

For a person experiencing addiction, residential stability is a critical need for maintaining recovery. People often leave incarceration, treatment, or other institutional settings and return to environments that fostered their alcohol and drug use.

Recovery Housing provides a living environment free from alcohol and illicit drug use and centered on peer support and connection to services that promote sustained recovery. Recovery housing focuses on assisting residents with

- Continued sobriety
- · Improved individual health physical, emotional, relational, spiritual
- · Positive community involvement work, school, volunteer organizations, recovery communities
- Connection to treatment or other recovery support services

Research indicates that the longer a person remains in a recovery environment, the greater the chance of long-term sobriety, increased financial well-being, and overall stability. Recovery housing:

- Decreases Substance Use
- Decreases Incarceration Rates
- Increases Income
- Increased Family & Social Functioning
- Improves Psychological & Emotional Well-Being
- Increases Quality of Life
