Transportation barriers preventing individuals from attending support group meetings, counseling sessions, or other essential recovery services.



Employment and Training Transportation Needs

Limited options for transportation to and from job training programs or employment opportunities, which can hinder the recovery community's economic stability.



Limited Access to Social Services

Challenges in reaching social services, community resources, and government offices that play a crucial role in supporting individuals on Medicaid and in recovery.

- Member of the Windham School Board since 2020



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



Hope on Wheels: Innovation Differentiators

- Unique Approach: seamlessly integrating the missions of a recovery house and a transportation provider to create a holistic solution.
- Organic Evolution to Address Gaps: This program organically evolved to fill crucial transportation gaps for both the recovery and Medicaid communities, showcasing adaptability and responsiveness to community needs.
